Course Description-This course reviews the material covered in French I and increases comprehension, speaking, reading, and writing ability. While the emphasis in French I is designed on sound of the language, basic grammar, and listening/speaking skills, level II concentrates on syntax, more advanced grammar and the expansion of vocabulary, reading, and writing skills. Students practice language skills using the IPAD, audio, visual, internet resources, small groups and partner practice.

Course Outcomes

- Listening-Comprehension of authentic materials (videos, movies, songs) engage in conversations and follow teacher's directions in French.
- Reading-Learn French vocabulary, use French/English dictionaries, read and comprehend short articles and stories in French.
- Speaking-Learn pronunciation and intonation, ask questions, give answers, participate in conversations, and give oral presentations in French.
- Grammar-Learn more advanced grammar structures, utilize learned grammar in reading, writing, and speaking French.
- Writing-Write compositions in French.
- Culture-Study French customs more in depth.
